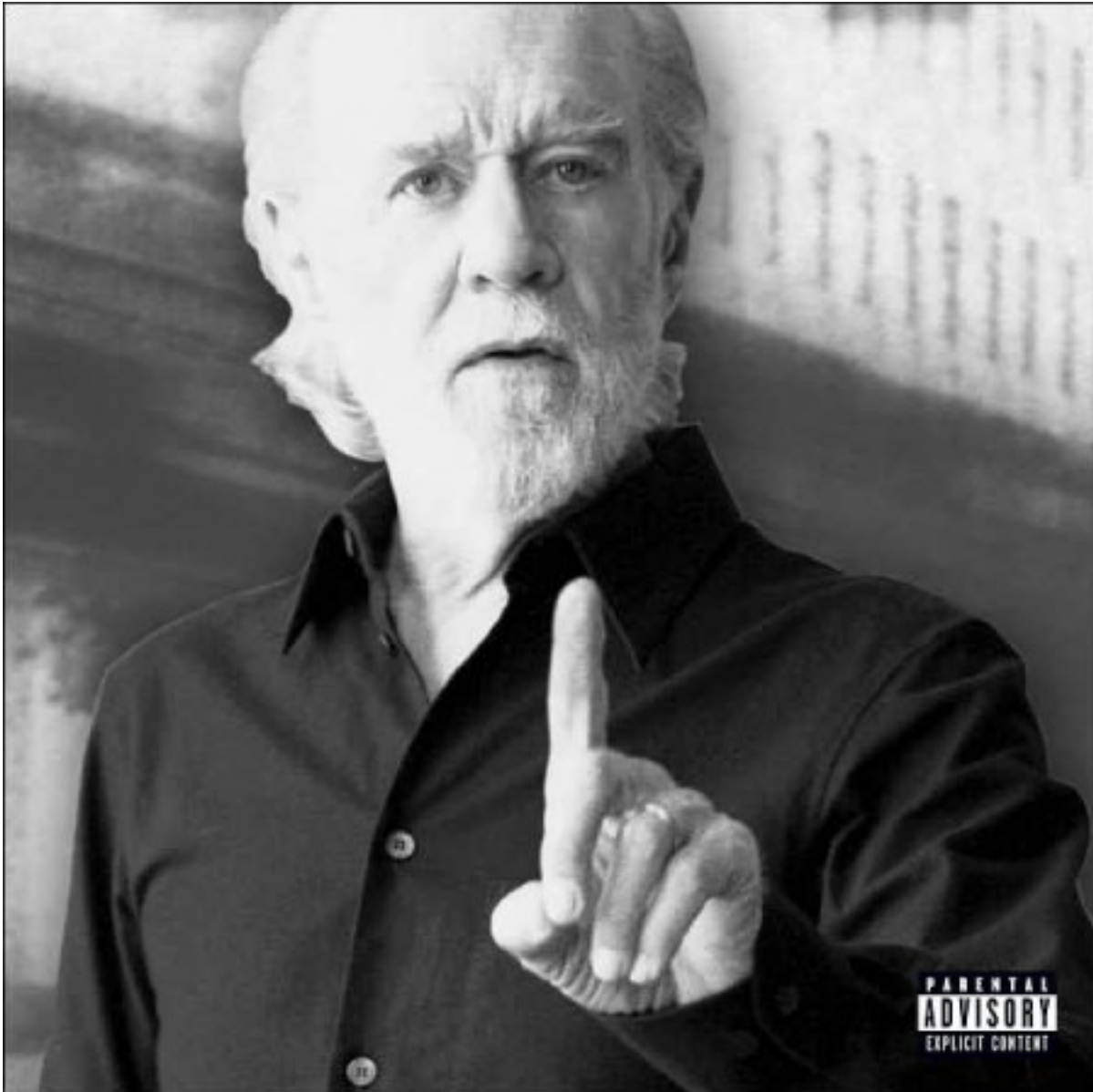


A Comedic(?) Break
