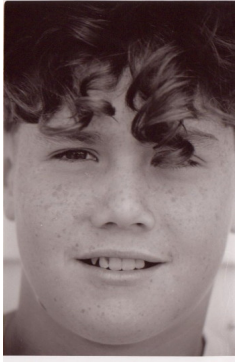


Stuff
