We built the hotel (and this is today) on the left. Looks pretty small from this view, huh?

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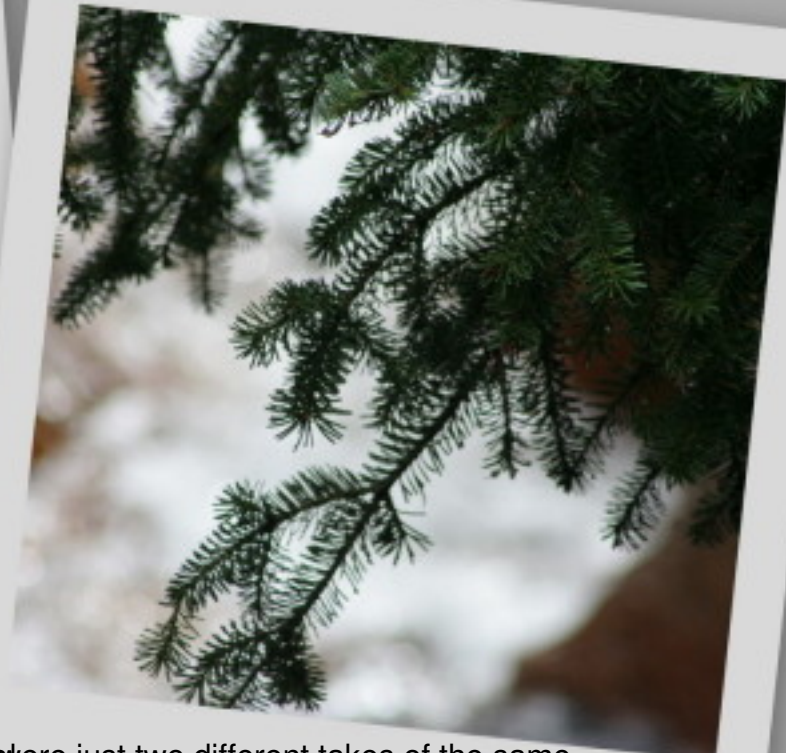


Not the top of the ridge and please do not come across this creek
